Rising popularity of medical tourism

Rising popularity of medical tourism reveals deterioration of U.S.and European healthcare system Defenders of organized medicine are fond of saying that the United States and European countries has the best healthcare in the world, but I challenge that. I don't think they have the best healthcare in the world, I think they have the most expensive healthcare in the world. In fact, in terms of results for moneys spent, I think the United States and European countries ranks very near the bottom of the list of all industrialized nations. We get less actual health than anyone else for each money that we spend. This realization is now hitting the general public as well, and they are increasingly leaving this country to find offshore locations and assess quality medical care and surgical procedures elsewhere. This phenomenon is called "medical tourism."

In medical tourism, patients who might normally undergo some sort of medical procedure in the U.S.A and European Countries usually a costly surgical procedure, instead fly to the Turkey or other countries to have the procedures done there.

As a result, they save an enormous amount of money. Offshore medical procedures can be performed for as little as one-tenth the cost of what would normally be charged here in the U.S.A and European Countries. And yet the facilities offshore are state of the art. These are modern clinics that often are newer and have much better technology and equipment than hospitals in the U.S.A and European Countries. They are typically staffed by Western educated doctors and surgeons trained in Western medicine, and they provide equal or greater quality surgical care than U.S.A and European Countries dental clinics. These surgical procedures are performed with the same technology and expertise, yet cost a fraction of the price.

For example, a porcelain crown in a high-tech clinic in the Turkey performed by Western trained dentists might only cost you \$150-200 Here in the United States you're probably looking at \$800-1000

So where do the cost savings come from? How come these hospitals offshore can offer these services at much lower prices? The answer lies in the economics of healthcare in the United States and the amount of fraud and waste that is present in the U.S. healthcare system. I've spoken to many MDs over the years, and some insist that as much as 80% of all healthcare dollars that go through their office cover nothing but paperwork.

Many workers in the health care industry are basically getting paid to shuffle paper around. The health insurance companies are paid to deny health claims and the government workers at Medicare and Medicaid offices are paid to find new ways to deny payments to doctors and hospitals for services rendered. Thus, doctors' offices and hospitals have to employ entire armies of people to sit around and reclassify procedures in ways that can get paid by insurance companies, Medicare and Medicaid. It's a massive waste of time, money and effort.

Clinical and economical outcome evaluation of dental care services received by German patients in countries outside the EU

[Article in German]

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Purpose: During the past decade German patients developed an increasing tendency to dental health tourism in countries outside the European Union. The present investigation aimed at evaluating both clinical and economic outcome of dental care in these countries with regard to German directive standards. METHODS: Based on physical examinations performed by the Medizinische Dienst der Krankenversicherung Rheinland-Pfalz in the context of reimbursement or regress requests after dental care in countries outside the European Union, an individual treatment concept was designed and its direct costs from the patient's perspective were estimated according to German standards. Furthermore, the clinical outcome was evaluated and treatment concepts for the correction of clinically relevant findings were simulated; the corresponding costs were estimated. A descriptive cost-cost analysis has

been performed from the patient's perspective and a secondary one from the health service's perspective.

Results: A total of 60 examinations (january 2001 to october 2002) were analysed. 29 of these 60 patients showed clinically relevant findings affording post treatment correction, among which 23 treatment concepts significantly disagreed with German directive standards. From the 60 patients' perspective median costs of 942 euro; for treatment outside the EU versus hypothetical costs of 750 euro; for treatment in Germany were observed. In addition, the 29 patients with clinically relevant findings affording corrective treatment implied median costs of 1,383 euro;. From the health service perspective, median costs of 761 euro; could be avoided due to treatments outside the EU, whereas median costs of 1,220 euro; were simulated due to necessary corrective treatments.

Conclusion: From the patients' perspective dental care outside the EU has to be reconsidered both from a clinical and an economic point of view.

Going to the Dentist

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There is no need to be concerned about the quality of dental care, or any other kind of health care, in Germany. It's comparable in just about every way with the care you get stateside, and there are even some who think it's better. The Germans are very thorough, and do lots of testing.

There is no shortage of dentists in Germany, not even in rural areas. On the contrary there are, by just about any criterion, too many. There were warnings in the 1970s that not enough young people were studying dentistry, and the present surplus appears to be the result of an overcompensation. Of Germany's 59,000 dentists, 720 are even listed as unemployed.

And the situation isn't likely to improve any time soon. There are still too many dental students.

Since 1993 the state-run insurers have been barred from accrediting more dentists than have been statistically determined to be needed in their areas, no more than one per 2,400 population. There is no requirement that a dentist have this accreditation. But if he doesn't have it he can accept no state-plan patients and private patients are hard to come by in these days of a dentist surplus.

All this has led to some downward pressure on the prices they charge. The real income of the average dentist has declined since 1980. But shed no crocodile tears for them. Their average income is still two and one-half times that of all Germans.

So dental work over here remains expensive, especially if you don't have adequate insurance coverage. And German dentists have a reputation for claiming that a large amount of dental work must be done.

There may be some language problems but, as with educated Germans in general, many dentists speak some English and it shouldn't be hard to find one who can work with you. Ask your friends and business colleagues.

Dental emergency services are available throughout the country. You'll find a list of the numbers to call at dentists' offices, pharmacies, hospitals, police and fire stations and in the daily newspapers. There is also a telephone number, 110, that you can call in the event of a dental or any other kind of emergency.

Dental work can be covered by health insurance, but things are a bit complicated here so it pays to investigate. There are two basic kinds of health insurance in Germany, and both have provisions for covering some, but seldom all, of the costs of dental care. There are state-run plans (Gesetzliche Krankenversicherung) and private plans.

Insured persons, whether under the state-run or private plans, are covered for routine procedures such as simple fillings and dental hygiene. But major dental work, such as crowns and dentures, is only partially covered by the state plans. The patient will receive a bill for some of the work.

Privately insured persons may fare better with major dental work. But they should investigate carefully the type of dental coverage they have purchased. German companies usually limit the coverage new policyholders can receive. They probably will require a waiting period of eight months before they will make any reimbursements at all, and after that restrict their reimbursements to 60% to 80% of the total cost of major dental work.

Payments to dentists under the state-run plans are being cut in other areas too as part of a big government program to trim expenditures. This could well mean that if you have state-run insurance you could be left holding the bag for more of your dentist bill than before. It's a good idea to check with your state-run insurer and find out what sort of dental coverage it provides. You might want to purchase some inexpensive supplemental coverage from a private insurer.

Anyone faced with major dental work should get a detailed cost estimate (Heil- und Kostenplan) before any work is begun and submit it to their insurer for prior approval.

Dentists in Turkey - Qualifications

Following 5 years of training in one of Turkey's dentistry faculties graduates receive a degree of D.D.Though there is no madatory continuing education, joining the Turkish Dental Association obligates its members to attend training and skills development programmes. The Council of Higher Education is responsible for regulating dental education and the Ministry of Health is the registering authority. There are two recognised specialties: Prosthodontics and Orthodonty. Though there is no mandatory continuing education, members of the Turkish Dental Association have an obligation to develop and update their skills, in accordance with the associations commitment to high standards of dental care.

Travel Options

Though Istanbul the capital is well served with airlines, the coastal destinations can sometimes offer cheaper flights, particularly during holiday season. Antalya is major charter flights destinations

Dental Organizations

Dentistry falls under the supervision of the Ministry of Health which is responsible for regulating dentistry faculties and the legal framework within which Turkish dentistry operates. The Turkish Dental Association (TDA) is the central body responsible for co-ordinating the professional development of dentistry within Turkey. The organization is spread across the country, with about 33 dental chambers regulating locally issues. These chambers send delegates to a centralized committee structure that decides the national direction of the profession.

Dental Ethics

The Turkish Dental Association provides a comprehensive ethical guide for its members, covering their members to improving standards of care, their relationship with their patients, fair pricing etc... The TDA is a member of international dental organizations and its ethical standards are informed by and contribute to European and world dentistry.

Complaints

The TDA can appoint an arbitrator in case of disagreement between a dentist and their patient. If arbitration is not achieved the Supreme Disiplinary Committee meets 3 times a year and has the power to censure, fine or dismiss a dentist from practice. Recourse through the civil courts is always an option for either party if they are unhappy with the TDA's response.

Data Protection

Turkey is working on an implementation of its draft for the protection of personal data act. This is based on the European Data Protection Directive. Individuals also have a right to access information about them through Law No: 4982: Turkish Law on the Right to Information.

Tips for choosing a dentist

The TDA would like to assist consumers in making an informed choice of a dental practitioner. As an TDA member, a dentist is part of a professional association whose mission is a commitment to the public's oral health, ethics, science and professional advancement; leading a unified profession through initiatives in advocacy, education, research and the development of standards. Each TDA member dentist agrees to adhere to high ethical standards of conduct. These standards are embodied in the TDA Principles of Ethics and Code of Professional Conduct.

Are you planning a vacation that includes dental care outside your country? Here are some things you should know before you go.

If you are thinking about going to TURKEY for your dental care as part of a vacation (also known as "Dental Tourism"), here are some things to consider: Dentists practicing in the TURKEY attend five years at an accredited dental school. They pass dentistry faculty examinations before they receive a license to practice. Dentistry faculties have rules and regulations that dentists must follow.

In Turkey; dental offices regarding 1- educating and protecting dental health-care personnel; 2-preventing transmission of bloodborne pathogens; 3- hand hygiene; 4- personal protective equipment; 5- contact dermatitis and latex hypersensitivity; 6- sterilization and disinfection of patient-care items; 7-environmental infection control; 8- dental unit waterlines, biofilm, and water quality; 9- special considerations (e.g., dental handpieces and other devices, radiology, parenteral medications, oral surgical procedures, and dental laboratories

Dentists in Turkey are also held to a high standard of care. For example, they must follow infection control guidelines to prevent bloodborne illnesses from spreading. They must abide by regulations for radiation safety (X-ray equipment and its use) and for proper waste disposal. These standards are in place for your safety and for that of dental office staff.

Before you come

Before you travel out of your country for dental care, check with the health department or ministry in the destination country to see what national guidelines are in place for dentists. The Organization for Safety and Asepsis Procedures (OSAP) has a Traveler's Guide to Safe Dental Care, which includes a checklist for safe dental treatment abroad. The International Association for Medical Assistance to Travellers, (IAMAT), maintains a network of medical personnel, hospitals and clinics around the world that have agreed to treat IAMAT members in need of care. IAMAT is helpful in referring patients to dentists. Any traveler can belong to IAMAT. There is no membership fee, although a donation is welcome.

Why is treatment so inexpensive?
